

The Nusselt-Reynolds Prize 2021

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NOMINATORS

NOMINATIONS UNTIL THE 30th OF NOVEMBER, 2021

The Prize Board welcomes nominations of selected individuals who submitted a prenomination. The Prize Board will select up to three final nominators maximum for each of the subjects “Heat Transfer”, “Fluid Flow” and “Thermodynamics”. The selected nominators will be requested to complete full nomination packages in the recommended form as described below.

A final nomination package based on the forms attached below should arrive not later than the *30th of November, 2019*, at the address mentioned below and should include:

1. The completed nomination form given on following pages, with additional pages attached for detailed information, if necessary. All attached forms with all specific information may be generated on a computer.
2. A letter from the principal nominator describing how the nominee meets the criteria of the prize.
3. A minimum of **four** additional supporting letters from other sponsors of the nomination who are familiar with the nominee's contributions. At least two of these letters should be from two different countries that differ from the country of the principal nominator.
4. A curriculum vitae of the nominee to include other qualifications that are not outlined in the nomination form.

The foregoing material should be solicited and assembled by the principal nominator. The completed nomination package should be sent to the address mentioned below.

The prize recipient will be asked to prepare a written state-of-the-art review paper covering an area selected by the recipient and present a special lecture at the 10th World Conference during *May 30th to June 4th 2021*, Rhodes, Greece. The prize will be bestowed at this occasion. The review will be published in the Conference Proceedings.
